

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCES AGREEMENT

Auburn University

Before graduating, students in Ph.D. programs must submit evidence that they have completed several professional experiences commonly associated with faculty positions in higher education.

This agreement must be submitted to the doctoral committee for its approval at the time that the committee meets to review the Plan of Study. One copy must be submitted to the Department Head with the Plan of Study; the student and the major professor should each keep a copy.

I. SCHOLARLY WRITING

Every candidate must submit at least one scholarly manuscript to a journal editor. The major professor must approve the manuscript if it is developed after the candidate has been admitted.

II. OPTIONS

Every candidate must complete at least three of the following types of experiences:

- Teaching in undergraduate professional courses
Supervising interns as a university supervisor
Making scholarly presentations at professional conferences
Presenting inservice sessions to teachers
Conducting independent or joint research (in addition to dissertation research)
Developing and submitting grant proposals
Other higher-education-related professional experiences
