## Application Steps

SEND TO AU GRADUATE SCHOOL:

Complete and submit a **Graduate School Application** available at [www.grad.auburn.edu](http://www.grad.auburn.edu), The Graduate School, Hargis Hall, Auburn University, Alabama 36849.

It will include the following:

- **Graduate Record Examination** (GRE) scores (AU Code #1005), taken within the last 5 years. *GRE scores not required for Certification-only applications.*
- **Official transcript(s)** of previous college and university work
- **Application fee**

SEND TO EFLT DEPARTMENT:

1. Submit **three recommendations**—either letters or EFLT Graduate Study recommendation forms are acceptable. The form is available through the EFLT office or through the **APPLICATION** webpage link at: [www.auburn.edu/eflt](http://www.auburn.edu/eflt)
2. Submit a **Statement of Intent** (500 word maximum) indicating your professional interest(s) and goals. It can include: current goals for your professional career, reason for selecting your major field of study, type of position(s) you expect to seek when you complete the program of study covered by this application, your philosophy of education, professional issues of most concern or interest to you at this time, and/or areas of research interests.

*\* Note: The Instructional Leadership Preparation Program (ILPP) requires additional admissions steps – please contact Program Coordinator.*

## Helpful Hints

- Submit recommendations and the statement of intent to the Program Coordinator, Educational Foundations, Leadership and Technology (EFLT) Department, 4036 Haley Center, Auburn University, AL 36849. Please do not send to the Graduate School.
- The Master’s Instructional Leadership Preparation (ILP) program [**listed as Education, Adm Elem & Secondary Ed (Instr Ldrship), Masters**] requires additional admissions steps. Please contact Dr. Lynne Patrick, ILP Program Coordinator at [rlp0004@auburn.edu](mailto:rlp0004@auburn.edu) or 334.844.3024 for more details.
- If you have taken the GRE within the past five years and have your scores, you can complete that section. Otherwise, leave that section blank.
- Once you enter the E-application, please be prepared with the following information:

**Name; Mailing Address; Permanent Address / Phone, Personal Information; Nation of Citizenship; Previous College (including College/University Name, City, GPA, Degree dates, & major); GRE Test Scores; and Planned Course of Study.**

### WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN USING THE GRADUATE SCHOOL E-APPLICATION:

1. Go to: <http://www.grad.auburn.edu/>
2. Click on APPLY ONLINE
3. Select E-APPLICATION
4. Admissions Login – Click on FIRST TIME USER ACCOUNT CREATION
5. Create a Login ID. Do not use your userid. Use your first name or last name (up to 9 characters).
6. Create a PIN number (any six numbers you like).
7. Verify PIN number (repeat the six numbers you entered in the previous block)

8. Click on LOGIN. You are now at the “Select an Application Type” page.
9. Select the appropriate status option. Domestic are the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the bottom option (see example below):

**Graduate US Citizen/Permanent Resident (Domestic):** A citizen or a permanent resident of the United States who has graduated from an accredited 4 year institution of higher learning with at least a Baccalaureate Degree or the equivalent of a 4 year Baccalaureate Degree who wishes to pursue an advanced degree (Masters, Specialist, Doctorate).

10. Click on CONTINUE.
11. Proceed through the application.
12. PRINT the page that says PAY NOW or GO BACK TO THE GRAD SCHOOL WEBSITE. Make sure you have the application Reference Number. If you are an AU employee, DO NOT pay the application fee.
13. If you are **not** an AU employee, select PAY NOW and complete the application (use a credit card or make check payable to: Auburn University).
14. If you are an **AU employee**, select GO BACK TO THE GRADUATE SCHOOL WEBSITE. This completes and submits the application. Then, send an email to Ms. Jennifer Lovelace – [jml0006@auburn.edu](mailto:jml0006@auburn.edu) to request the AU employee application fee waiver. Be sure to include your reference number (here is a sample):
