Exhibits for the **Overview of the Institution** (OI) and the **Conceptual Framework** (CF) are number sequentially. The remaining exhibits are coded by **standard** (first number), by **element** (second number), and by **order** within the element (third number). For example, Exhibit 2.3.4 represents Standard 2, Element 3 and is the fourth exhibit in this element. If an exhibit is coded with a "0" as the second number, it provides background information for the standard and/or contains information applicable to multiple elements.
